WAIVER

As a volunteer, you acknowledge and agree that:

1. You are over the age of 18.
2. You will volunteer on the dates and at the times agreed Hut2Hut
3. You must report to your Hut2Hut contact when you arrive for your shift. You will be wholly responsible for your own transport to and from the Event.
4. You must, at all times, follow the directions of your Hut2Hut contact in relation to the Event. You must notify your Hut2Hut contact if you are not capable of undertaking any task (including due to any pre-existing injury), or if you are not properly skilled or qualified to undertake any task.
5. We reserve the right to refuse you entry to or remove you from any Event site, particularly if you fail to follow our directions or if you do anything to bring the Event into disrepute.
6. You must report all safety hazards or incidents to your Hut2Hut contact (or their delegated representative). You must pay due attention to the health and safety of all Event staff, participants and the general public whilst volunteering at the Event. You will comply with all health and safety policies, guidelines and procedures notified to you in relation to the Event.
7. You participate in the Event solely as a volunteer and at your own risk.
8. Hut2Hut, Oscars 100, Tour de Trails and all organisations involved in the management of the event will not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury that you may suffer or incur relating to or arising from the Event.
