AVENZA MAPS - Mapping App for Oscars Hut 2 Hut – Apple Instructions

We highly recommend loading the free app Avenza Maps onto your phone to help you find where you are in an emergency. Once set up, the app works WITHOUT mobile reception

INSTALLING & OPENING AVENZA MAPS

- 1. Open app store
- 2. Search for, and install "Avenza Maps"
- 3. Once installed, open Avenza Maps
- 4. If asked, allow Avenza Maps to access your location while using the app
- 5. Press "x" on the screen that says "sign in" and "I'm new"
- 6. You will find yourself on the "Maps" screen:

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LOADING MAPS

- 1. Open this web page on the device that you have installed Avenza maps on.
- 2. Copy the following link (long press on top of the link & select "copy")
- 3. <u>https://www.eventsafetyservices.com.au/eventmaps/archies-55km-v240120-1107hrs.tif</u> [note that this map is the 55km course / two loops for Hut2Hut 105km participants, based on alternative arrangements for 2020 event]
- 4. Go to Avenza Maps
- 5. Click the "+" symbol at top right

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6. Paste the link you copied earlier into "From the Web"

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7. Press "Go"

- 8. After the map has finished downloading & processing, tap to open.
- 9. If you would like to change the name of the map, click the "i" symbol at top right and choose a different title

USING AVENZA MAPS

To make full use of Avenza maps, GPS must be turned on in your device. See troubleshooting if you need help with this*

- 1. On the map, key locations are marked with yellow labels, and the route is marked as a semitransparent blue line.
- 2. The latitude and longitude numbers at the bottom of screen correspond to the point that the cross-hairs are targeting at centre screen.
- 3. Therefore, you can scroll around to any position on the map & determine the co-ordinates of the point between the cross-hairs.
- 4. Your current GPS location is displayed on the map as a blue dot.
- 5. Press the Location Button to centre in on your current location. Once this is done, your current lat/long co-ordinates will match the lat/longs displayed on the screen. This will only work if you are physically located within the map boundaries.

TROUBLESHOOTING

*Devices with an inbuilt GPS chip (most smart phones and tablets) can determine your geographical position using GPS (Global Positioning System). This does not rely on having mobile reception. Follow the instructions below if you don't know how to turn on GPS.
